Covering an area of more than 3,200ha, a vast site of Rason Bird reserve is comprised of various wetland
types such as meadow, freshwater and saltwater ecosystems, marshes, freshwater lake, river, streams,
etc. As an important habitat for migratory birds, it was designated as Rason Migratory Bird(Wetland)
Reserve(1997) in 1997 and included in the list of Wetlands of international importance since 2013.
