

Deep Concern about Working Conditions

One January day in 2017, the respected Comrade Kim Jong Un visited the newly-built Pyongyang Bag Factory.

After giving advice on the production of schoolbags, he looked round the shop floor with deep concern about working and living conditions for the employees.

At the sewing workshop he sat on an ordinary stool and looked carefully at the LED lights hanging over the sewing machines.

He told officials that the lights should be bright enough for the convenience of the machine operators, adding that if they worked under poor lighting for eight hours a day, they might feel pain in their eyes.
